Division

Divide means share into equal groups

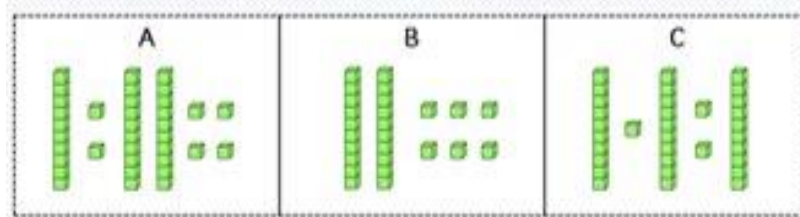

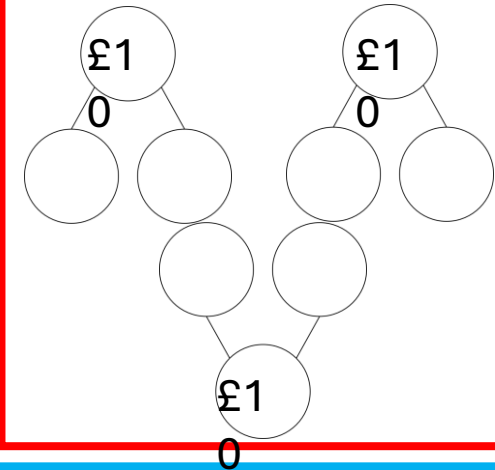
Addition and subtraction

$$\begin{array}{l} 26 + 24 = \\ 19 + 41 = \\ 90 + 10 = \\ 76 + 14 = \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{l} 30 - 13 = \\ 50 - 23 = \\ 60 - 33 = \\ 70 - 43 = \end{array}$$

Multiplication
