b) $205 \div 5 =$

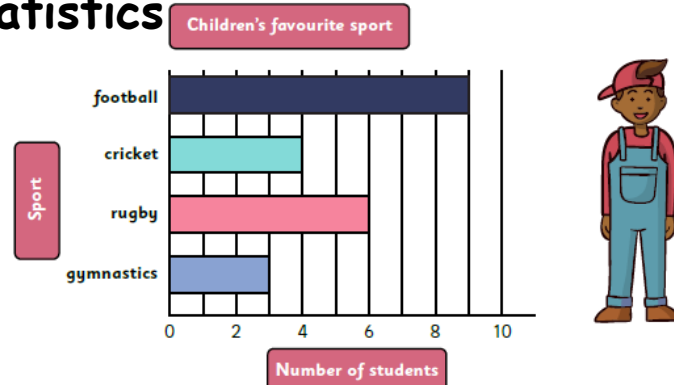
c) $105 \div 7 =$
