Many people think they know what Jesus taught but it is only when you read the Gospels that you realise how radical his teaching really is. This half-term we are using Matthew's Gospel to examine what Jesus really said and see if we can apply this to our own lives. Sometimes he taught through parables (sometimes explaining them too) but he was also very clear in his direct teaching. We will look back at his view of the Old Testament and conclude with the events of Easter.
