b) $205 \div 5 =$

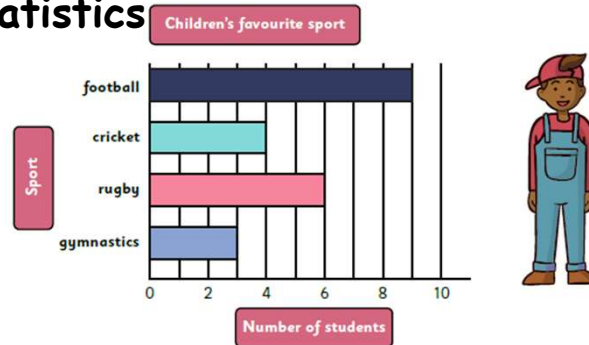
